FARM-TO-PANTRY

- Distributed over 25,000 lbs of freshly-picked produce to 14 food access sites
- Delivered weekly farm boxes to 28 families in need, in the summer months
- Supported over two dozen local farms with direct purchasing at a fair price

GIVE & TAKE

- Opened 4 new sites, for a total of 19 sites
- Built 8 new Give & Take sheds with help from community members
- Exchanged over 10,000 lbs of produce in neighborhoods across Waldo County
- Distributed 1800 seedlings and seed packets to home gardeners
- Featured on WABI-TV, Republican Journal, Maine Monitor, and Maine Women Magazine

VEGGIES FOR ALL

- Gleaned 22,000 lbs of vegetables from 8 farms with about 275 volunteer hours in the fields
- Distributed 200 flats of organic vegetable seedlings to food pantry visitors countywide
- Processed hundreds of gleaned tomatoes with volunteers, for winter enjoyment by soup kitchen clientele
